

PERSONALIZING LEATHER



What is debossing?

Answer: Pressure and heat is applied to the leather – depressing (or branding) an image into the product. Our debossed products always have dark, deep, readable imprints.

Can the imprint be debossed in other areas?

Answer: On most products, it is probable. Our production team would need to review the item and advise if another imprint location is available and what imprint size is available.

Can you deboss more than one item using the same debossing die?

Answer: Yes. However the imprint size may need to be adjusted on one of the items in order to utilize the same debossing die for both products.

I have a die on file from an order last year. Can I use this die and avoid a die charge?

Answer: Yes. However, the imprint size may need to be adjusted to accommodate the existing die size.

What is laser etching?

Answer: Metal backers are attached to the leather product. We have stock colors of silver or antique gold metal backers that have been predetermined for the products where this is available. A plate is then laser etched with an imprint and attached to the metal backer. The personalized plate is black with either a silver or gold underlay. The underlay color shows through the black and matches the metal backers. Many styles utilizing this method can be produced with a quantity of one.

What is a domed medallion?

Answer: Domed medallions are available on the Urban Edge by Canyon line. This is a subtle full color domed medallion that is attached to the bags. PMS matching may not be exact, but we can get very close. Many styles can be produced with a quantity of one.

Can I get Urban Edge products with no medallion?

Answer: A few of the products do not have holes in the leather patch and can be ordered blank. However, most of the Urban Edge items have two holes in the leather patch to allow for the medallion. If product is ordered without a medallion, these holes would be visible. We suggest putting a generic Urban Edge logo on the medallion.
